Pinecrest's Second Annual Chili Cook-off this Saturday

There will be entertainment for the entire family with:

- Airbrush tattoos and face painting
- Pie and watermelon eating competitions
- The Miami Heat dancers and Burnie

The 18 Wheelers, a hard driving honky-tonk country band from the southland, will perform in the Bayan Bowl at 1 p.m.

Admission is \$5 and parking is free. Overflow parking will be available at Pinecrest Elementary (10250 Red Road), Palmetto Middle School (7351 SW 128 Street) and Miami Palmetto Senior High School (7460 SW 118 Street) with the Pinecrest People Mover making continuous stops for pick-up and drop-off from 10 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

All proceeds go the Community Foundation of Pinecrest, a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving Pinecrest Gardens, which was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in October 2011.
