Seniors benefited from a variety of health services provided by entities, such as Baptist Health and Mount Sinai Medical Center, which provided cholesterol and blood pressure screenings. Car Fit by the Florida Department of Transportation educated older drivers about driving safety, the Department of Motor Vehicles was onsite issuing license renewals and identification cards, and the Pinecrest Police Department's Crime Specialist gave attendees tips on how to be safer in their homes and how to start a Neighborhood Watch group.

Other groups that included the Alliance for Aging, Miami-Dade Transit, and Miami-Dade Public Libraries were also in attendance providing valuable information and goodies. The event ended with a raffle where attendees won generous gift certificates for massages, Joanne's Market and Roasters and Toasters.

And for the first time the Senior Fair extended into Pinecrest Gardens where the Pinecrest Gardens' horticulturist taught a horticulture class, and attendees were invited to tour the botanical gardens while learning its history along the way.
