*Pinecrest Police to host a gun safety workshop to teach children and parents life-saving tips on gun safety*

**Pinecrest, Fla.** – The Pinecrest Police Department will be hosting a gun safety workshop to teach children and parents life-saving tips Thursday, February 19th at 7:00 p.m. in the Pinecrest Community Center, 5855 Killian Drive. The Gun Safety for Children and Parents Workshop is a free and interactive workshop that is open to the community and will provide tips on proper methods on safely handling, securing and storing firearms. Police will present appropriate types of storage safes and locations to store firearms, and go over the different types of gunlocks available.

Crime Prevention Unit Supervisor Sergeant Michael Gorsline developed the workshop to be tailored for children and parents. It will provide an open forum to exchange ideas and concerns while providing an overview about the dangers of firearms and how to safely handle and store firearms.

A few common gun safety tips are: 1) Store guns in a locked location, unloaded, out of the reach and sight of children 2) store ammunition in a separate locked location, out of the reach and sight of children and 3) Keep the keys and combinations hidden.
