*Five Palmetto Elementary Student Ambassadors to bury Pinecrest Time Capsule*

**Pinecrest, FL** - Five students from Palmetto Elementary School, each one representing grades 1 through 5 will bury a time capsule at 2:30 p.m. Wednesday, March 2nd at the Pinecrest Municipal Center, 12645 Pinecrest Parkway.

At the event each student will answer the question: What do you think Pinecrest will be like in 30 years? The capsule is scheduled to be unlocked 30 years from now during the Village's 50th anniversary. The hope is that these tiny ambassadors will participate in the opening of the time capsule in 2046 and pass on their memories of Pinecrest.

The capsule contains a myriad of items that represent the Village today and includes a Palmetto Elementary School yearbook. It is part of the Village's 20th anniversary celebration, and contains other items that include a 2016 coin set, a Pinecrest Police patch, a replica Pinecrest street sign, mementoes with the 20th anniversary logo, and copies of various publications of the Village.
