


FEMA Flood Zones

- X - Area determined to be outside the 500-year flood and protected by levee from 100-year flood
- .2 PCT ANNUAL CHANCE - Area inundated by 500-year flooding or by 100-year flooding with average depths of less than 1 foot or with drainage areas less than 1 square mile; or an area protected by levees from 100-year flooding.
- AE - The base floodplain where base flood elevations are provided
- AH - Areas with a 1% annual chance of shallow flooding, usually in the form of a pond, with an average depth ranging from 1 to 3 feet. These areas have a 26% chance of flooding over the life of a 30-year mortgage
