Police are looking for a hit-and-run suspect who struck three cyclists

Pinecrest, FL – On Sunday, June 3, 2018 at approximately 6:05 a.m., three cyclists were the victims of a hit-and-run crash. The cyclists were traveling south on SW 57th Avenue approaching SW 102nd Street when a vehicle also traveling south struck the cyclists and fled the scene. All three cyclists were injured and one was transported to the hospital and later released.

Based on the evidence recovered at the scene, the vehicle was identified as a beige and gray two tone 1999 – 2003 Lexus RX 300. The vehicle will be missing part of the passenger side rear view mirror, and possibly have passenger side body damage. The vehicle turned right heading west on SW 104th street, after striking the cyclists.

Police are asking anyone who has information about the vehicle or crash, to call police at 305.234.2100.
