Single Officer Response to Active Threats Training

Pinecrest Police Officers receive specialized training that will prepare them to enter an active shooter scene before back-up arrives.

Pinecrest, FL – The Police Department administration staff recognizes that providing officers with training and tactics that will enable a single-officer response has the potential to save lives. In a proactive move to provide officers training and preparation, the department put officers through **Single Officer Response to Active Threats** training – which is specifically designed for the officer who arrives to an active shooter event alone.

Police officers received specialized single-officer training aimed to neutralize the shooter(s) as quickly as possible while mitigating the loss of innocent lives. The training was held using state-of-the-art training gear that replicates real-life scenarios using a laser based system with tracking the trainees' movements and heartbeat. The training took place over days starting March 27th.
